Andrew Tsui remembers:

My father, brother and I all had quite a bit to do with HKU. Last year, I was mandated to mount a global search to head hunt a world-class academic leader to be the Vice-Chancellor of HKU. I was elated to have been entrusted with this very important, yet perceived to be a "mission impossible" task, before Professor Tsui Lap-Chee was appointed as a result of the search.

My eldest brother John Tsui was a former HKU Students' Union President. It went a lot further, my father Paul Tsui was the contemporary of Dr Rayson Huang, former Vice-Chancellor of the University. They both received wartime degrees when the Pacific War broke out in 1942. As a fresh HKU graduate, Paul soon found himself joining the anti-Japanese Intelligence Group led by

Sir Lindsay Ride, the then Vice-Chancellor of HKU, operating from what is today's Pearl River Delta. Having earned his stripes during the War, Paul made history by becoming the first local Administrative Officer (AO) to join the Hong Kong Government and had a distinguished career in public service.
