## Do I need to register to be an alum?

**No.** As you graduate from the HKU, you are a member of the alumni family of the University which is lifelong. All graduates are automatically members of Convocation (statutory body) of the University. You are entitled to copies of free Convocation Newsletter and a graduate email account. So, remember to update your contacts with the Alumni Office.

## Any alumni identity card?

**No.** But you may apply for the HKU Graduate Credit Card which provides you with a convenient way to enjoy the alumni privileges.

## Do I belong to any HKU alumni association?

Besides Convocation (statutory), there are 61 HKU alumni groups in Hong Kong and offshore. They are all independent. You can find their information on the alumni website.

## Can I receive news from the University by email?

**Yes.** You are welcome to send us your email contact or you can get a free and permanent HKU Graduate Email Account (@graduate.hku.hk). Besides the timely news of the University, ad hoc privileges for alumni are also sent through email.
